



## **Fire Extinguisher Training**

### **Background**

It is a legal requirement under the Regulatory Reform Order 2005 to carry out Fire Training. The level of training will depend on the role of the individual and the requirements identified in the companies Fire Risk Assessment. But as a minimum training should be conducted:

- Induction Training to cover general fire awareness on commencement of employment.
- Periodic refresher training, or extra training where the level of fire risk increases as a result of changes in your operations.
- Training to support people in meeting their fire safety duties - for example, keeping your 'responsible people' up to date.
- Training to build appropriate skills such as fire risk assessment, fire warden or using fire extinguishers.

### **Course Aims**

To give individuals the confidence and techniques in order to identify a fire type, to select the appropriate fire extinguisher confidently and safely.

### **Who Should Attend?**

This course is designed for any personnel who would be expected to use a fire extinguisher in an emergency.

### **Course Objectives**

- To provide employees with the basic knowledge to identify different classes of fire.
- To give individuals the confidence to operate the appropriate fire equipment safely and correctly.

### **Learning Outcomes**

- For the individual to understand the different classes of fire.
- For the individual to understand the components of the fire triangle.
- For the individual to safely and competently demonstrate the correct use of a fire extinguisher and fire blanket.
